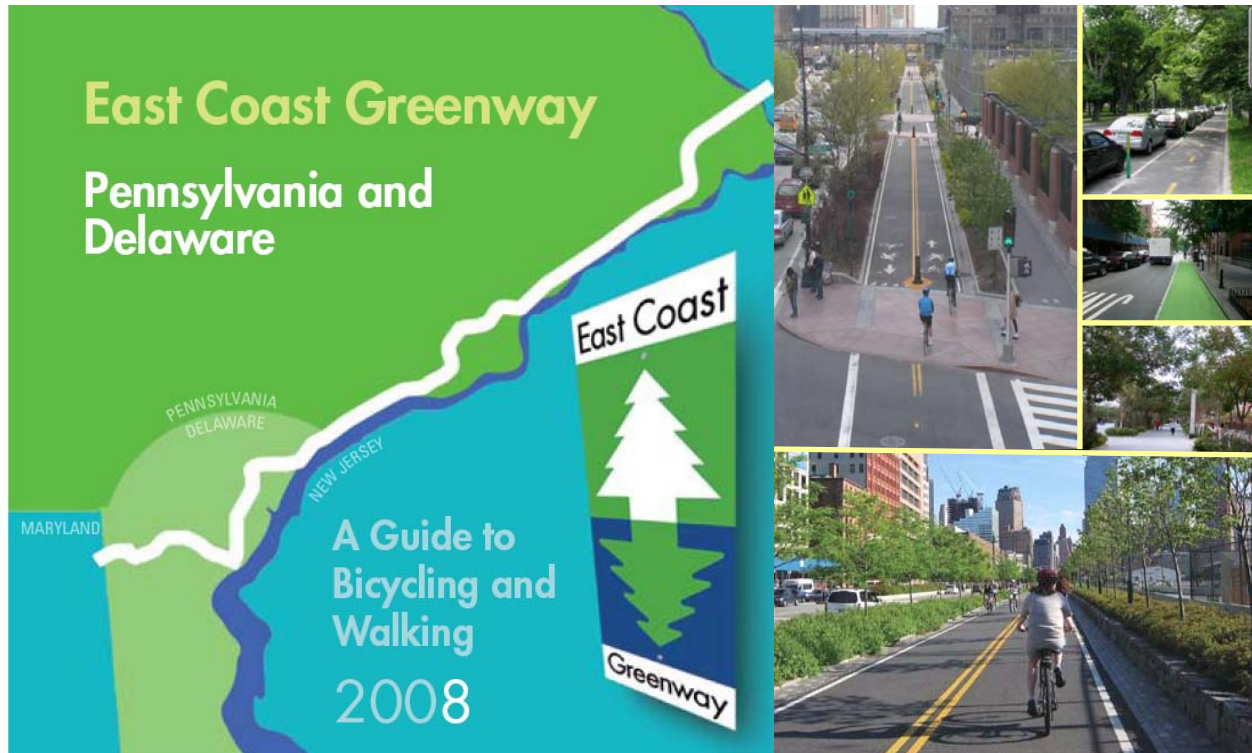


On the Forefront:
